Lobbying with legislators is one method to advocate for change.


SIGMA PURPOSE FOR HUMAN TRAFFICKING

underwear (young women: socks, bras, panties / young men: socks, underwear and T-shirts in various sizes)







Advocacy In Action: Planning and Executing an Effective Lobby Day

Getting the Most out of Advocacy Days requires advance planning from 3-12 months, dependent upon the level of government

 There are three phases of the lobby day much like all events: planning, execution, follow-up



Form a Committee

- Delegate responsibility amongst a team
- Determine tasks such as finance, logistics, political relations, communications
- Choose a point person to direct final information to

Create a Plan

- Determine your specific area of interest
- Select a phrase or mantra to motivate
- Check the legislative calendar to verify session dates
- Choose the date of the week when most legislators will be present
- Determine your expected outcome
- Determine how to measure your expected outcome
- Determine your budget
- Determine if you are lobbying for or against a bill
- Determine event structure



Strategize

- Strategy is dependent upon your lobby day goals
- If the goal is to push for a particular issue, meeting with elected officials in opposition to persuade them is effective
- It is ok to meet with elected officials who advocate for issues you support or even your own representatives if time permits or if the purpose is not pushing legislation

Meetings with elected officials

- Contact offices 4-8 weeks in advance
- Correspond via email and phone
- Reconfirm all dates a week prior to the event

- Create an Evite with pertinent information
- Ensure that your driver's license or state identification is valid and will not expire immediately before or during your event*
- When determining your topic, track its legislation to remain up to date

HOW TO CREATE AN EVENT IN EVENTBRITE

- After signing up or logging in online at Eventbrite, select
 "Create Event" at the top of the page
- Start creating a new event
- Choose what type of tickets to create
- Edit your ticket type
- Edit each ticket custom setting
- Options to change currency or reorder/rearrange your tickets will appear
- Save changes
- Purpose is to list the event; sell tickets, if necessary; and manage registration.

- Educate Attendees
 - Have a call or webinar to brief attendees prior to the event using information from subject matter experts
 - Create and distribute packets with talking points, directions, meeting schedules (15 minutes tops), elected official bios, contact information of attendees, and other relevant information

The Day of the Event: Execution

Have a Quick Morning Gathering

- Ensure all attendees are clear on the purpose and equipped for the conversations of the day i.e. talking points, etc.
- Use your mantra or phrase to energize and motivate
- Remind attendees to document legislative responses as they go

Utilize Day of Guides

- Have several people as guides who are knowledgeable of the space you are in to help navigate
- Establish meet up places

Have Fun and Go!

- Ensure you stay hydrated
- Wear comfortable attire and shoes
- Always have government identification visible on your person

SAMPLE TALKING POINTS AND ASK

<u>Theme</u>: In Plain Sight: Education and Advocacy to Eradicate Human Trafficking

Phrase: We provide information as we fight to eliminate human trafficking

- The average age of human trafficking victims is between 12 and 15 years old.
- 60% of child sex trafficking victims recovered are from foster care or group homes.
- Too often children are charged with prostitution or other sex related offenses rather than treated as victims. They are really victims of crime.
- Victims are targeted and sold quickly over the internet.

Ask: For these reasons, Sigma Gamma Rho asks that you support existing legislation supporting law enforcement, courts or anti-trafficking task forces to target the demand for children exploited for sex. Additionally, HB 123 will strengthen the child welfare system's response to sex trafficking by providing housing after the age of 18 for foster children.

The Day of the Event: Execution

During the Meetings

- Be flexible: sometimes those who you are meeting with may be in other meetings or in session and it may take time to get your scheduled meeting or you may have to meet with a staff person
- Be respectful of time limits
- Have materials to leave behind, business cards, contact information of the point person for follow up questions, sorority information
- End the meeting with a clear ask that was determined by the group

Enjoy Other Activities

 Plan and incorporate mixers, receptions, trainings, etc. in your day agenda to increase networking opportunities

Stay vigilant: Designate key members to track the progress of the issue in the months ahead and report on changes to the body.
