1. Why are we having a virtual conference?

While a surge in new COVID-19 cases across the world is prompting social distancing, limit seating and other preventive measures, the International Board of Directors and the Boule Planning Team have determined that moving to a virtual format for the 2021 Special Boule will protect the health, safety, and well-being of our Sorors, Affiliates, and Guests.

2. Will the dates of the conference stay the same?

Yes, we plan to host the 2021 Virtual Special Boule during the originally scheduled dates June, 3-6, 2021. You can expect some changes to the format of the schedule to ensure our conference works with a virtual experience.

3. What virtual platform will we use for the Virtual Conference?

We are planning to utilize a more robust virtual platform to provide attendees with an optimal virtual experience.

4. What does registration include?

Registration includes an immersive experience, access to the business session(s) and a premium exclusive gift. You will also be able to participate in workshops, undergraduate talent/step show, entertainment, awards & achievement celebration, praise/worship and visit the elite virtual vendor hall.

5. What are my options if I retained by registration from Boule 2020 and I plan to attend Special Boule 2021 and/or Centennial?

All attendees who retained their 2020 Boule Registration may submit the 2021 Boule Refund Allocation form through April 1, 2021. Below are the options available on how your retained registration will be applied.

1. Why is there tiered registration pricing for graduate and undergraduate members for Centennial Boule (July 2022)?

The registration pricing for Centennial Boule (July 2022) is structured in tiers in an effort to recognize members' financial contributions via Centennial assessments. The highest tiers (tier 3 for graduates and tier 2 for undergraduates) represent the base registration price for the respective member types.

2. How are the registration tiers for each member determined?

Registration tiers for graduate and undergraduate members are based on the number of sorority years each member was financial from 2013-14 to 2019-20.

3. Why is there such a wide range of years for graduates in tier 1?

Centennial assessments began in 2013-14 with the one-time \$100 assessment. The annual Centennial assessment began in 2017-18. Therefore, a graduate soror who was financial for 4 years during the period from 2013-14 to 2019-20 has paid the same amount in Centennial assessments as a graduate soror who has been financial for all 7 years.

4. What should I do if I have an issue while registering (including a discrepancy with the tier)?

Complete the 2021 Special Boule/Centennial Support Request form for assistance. You will receive a response within 3 business days.

- 5. When will hotel reservations open for the July 2022 Centennial Boule?
 Hotel reservations for the July 2022 Celebration will be available when registration opens on January 22, 2021. You must be registered for the July 2022 event to gain access to the hotel reservation system. Donors who qualify for free registration via Leadership Giving will be able to reserve their hotel upon completion of their pledge payments. A block of hotel rooms has been reserved for these donors.
- 6. How can I reserve a King room?

If you would prefer a room with just one King bed, please note that in the 'Special Requests' field when booking your room. Whilst not guaranteed, the housing bureau will work with the hotel to accommodate this request, and will contact you if a King room becomes available. At that time the housing bureau would update your reservation to a King room and resend an acknowledgement email.

- 7. Can I purchase individual tickets for the July 2022 events? Individual event tickets for July 2022 events will be available for sale beginning January 1, 2022, pending capacity. Individual ticket sales are non-refundable.
- 8. Can I earn the combo registration discount if I register for a single event, but for 2 people (myself and another attendee)?

No. Combo registration discounts are only applicable when a single attendee registers for Centennial Boule (July 2022) and Centennial Founders' Weekend (November 2022) during a single registration session.

9. Will reactivation packages be offered during Waves 2 & 3.

No, reactivation packages are only available during Wave 1. Members reactivating after April 15, 2021 must complete their reactivation via ICHQ prior to registering. Members who reactivate during the 2021-22 sorority year AND register for Centennial will receive a special gift.

10. Will members who are inducted after Centennial Boule registration closes (December 31, 2021) still have the opportunity to register and attend the July 2022 and/or November 2022 celebration?

An induction package inclusive of Centennial registration will be offered to new members inducted during the 2021-22 sorority year, prior to March 31, 2022. No registrations (outside of those earned via Leadership Giving) will be accepted after March 31, 2022. Please plan your TORCH calendars accordingly.

11. Does the registration fee include meals and transportation to off-site events?

Yes, the registration fee includes scheduled meals and transportation to official conference off-site events from the official hotels.

12. I have been a member for 50 or more years and/or I plan to be inducted as a Cultured Pearl at the Centennial Boule in July 2022? Do I qualify for Cultured Pearl registration pricing?

Your registration category is based on the date you register. Only those who

officially have been inducted as a Cultured Pearl are eligible for Cultured Pearl registration pricing.

13. I will graduate from my college/university during Waves 1-3. Should I register for the Jul 2022 Centennial Boule as a Graduate or Undergraduate?

Your registration category is based on the date you register. If you are an undergraduate the day that you register, then your registration fee would be paid at the Undergraduate rate.

- 14. Will registration transfers between different member/registrant types be accepted (e.g. registration transfer between soror and philo)?
 No. Only transfers between the same member/registrant type will be accepted.
- 15. How will transfers be managed when there is a difference in registration tiers (e.g. Soror A who is Tier 1 registers and later wants to transfer her registration to Soror B who is Tier 3)

In order to complete the transfer, the difference plus the transfer fee will need to be paid. Payment is due at the time of transfer.

Example:

Soror A registration rate: \$650

Soror B registration rate: \$750

16. What if the opposite scenario occurs (e.g. Soror A is transferring registration to Soror B. Soror B qualifies for a lower registration tier/cost than Soror A.)

The difference between the two registration packages will be refunded to Soror A less the transfer fee.

Example:

- Soror A registration rate: \$750
- Soror B registration rate: \$650

Refund to Soror A: \$750 - \$650 - \$50 transfer fee = \$50

17. Will partial refunds be offered (e.g. Soror registers for combo (Jul 2022 & Nov 2022) but later decides she can only one of the events)?

Yes. The unused portion will be refunded less the \$175 cancellation fee.

Example:

- Tier 1, Wave 1, Graduate member, July 2022/Nov 2022 combo registration price = \$925
- Refund of Nov 2022: \$325 \$175 = \$150
- **18.** Is the administrative fee for partial and full cancellation/refunds? Yes, the administrative fee for partial and full cancellations is the same (\$175).
- 19. Is the deadline for partial and full cancellations the same? Yes, the deadline for partial and full cancellations is the same.

20. I registered or made an installment payment for the Centennial Boule (July 2022) and/or Centennial Founders' Weekend (November 2022) during the 2020-21 sorority year. What happens to my registration if I'm not financial during the 2021-22 sorority year?

Members and affiliates who register during 2020-21 sorority year have until September 30, 2021 to pay 2021-22 national dues. As of October 1, 2021, members and affiliates who are not financial for the 2021-22 sorority year will have their registration cancelled and will be refunded the amount paid less the cancellation fee. Those who subsequently become financial may re-register (if registration is still open) at the prevailing rate.

21. Do I have to be financial at the time I register / make an installment payment?

Yes, members and affiliates must be financial at the time of registration and/or to make an installment payment.

22. If I select the Undergraduate partial registration for the July 2022 celebration, can I later choose to pay the difference and upgrade to the full package?

No. Undergraduate partial registration packages cannot be upgraded.

23. Is Undergraduate partial registration for the July 2022 celebration eligible for combo registration pricing?

No. Undergraduate partial registration packages are not eligible for combo (July 2022 + November 2022) registration pricing.

- 24. When will the first Centennial Boule (July 2022) activities begin?
 "Thee Homecoming" event at Butler will take place on Tuesday July 12, 2022 and is open to all July 2022 attendees. Tours and other activities will start at 10 a.m.
- 25. When will hotel reservations open for the November 2022 Celebration?

 Hotel reservations for the November 2022 Centennial Founders' Weekend will open January 1, 2022. You must be registered for the November 2022 event to gain access to the hotel reservation system. Donors who qualify for free registration via Leadership Giving will be able to reserve their hotel upon completion of their pledge payments (or after January 1, 2022, whichever is later). A block of hotel rooms has been reserved for these donors.
- 26. Can I purchase individual tickets for the November 2022 events?

 There will be no individual event ticket sales for the November 2022 Centennial Founders' Weekend activities.

27. The November 2022 package is limited to 1,000 registrations. Will the

registration close when we reach 1,000 registrants?

Yes, if we reach 1,000 registrants during Waves 1-3, Combo event registrations that include the November 2022 event will end immediately. Thereafter, members, affiliates, sigma gents, and guests will only be able to register for Boule 2021 (June 2021) and Centennial Boule (July 2022), and Wave 4 will not open. After capacity is reached for November 2022, the only additional attendees who will be allowed to register for and attend the November 2022 celebration will be those who earn free registration via Centennial Leadership Giving.

- 28. Are affiliates invited to the November 2022 Rededication Weekend?

 Yes, all of our Sigma affiliates are invited to the November 2022

 Rededication Weekend. However, we are cognizant that school will be in session, thereby restricting some members' and affiliates' ability to travel.

 We are therefore also planning activities that chapters and affiliates can do locally as well as livestreaming of some of the activities in Indianapolis.
- 29. Will there be airline travel discounts for the Centennial Boule activities in both July and November 2022?

As we've done in previous years, we will work with the airlines to provide discounted airfare rates available. We will communicate the information as soon as it is available. (See page 34)

LEADERSHIP GIVING

30. I plan to participate in Leadership Giving at a level that will entitle me to free registration. How will this work since registration for the July 2022 celebration ends 12/31/2021, but I have until 3/31/2022 to fulfill my Leadership Giving pledge? Will I be able to register and reserve a hotel room?

Donors who qualify for free registration via Leadership Giving will be able to register for the July and/or November celebrations as well as reserve their hotel upon completion of their pledge payments. A portion of the July 2022 and November 2022 event capacity as well as a block of hotel rooms have been reserved for these donors.

Please complete the Boule Refund Allocation form to indicate how you would like to use your Boule 2020 credit (apply to Special Boule and/or request a refund).

33. What is included in VIP Full Access?

VIP Full Access includes:

- Access to VIP receptions and after parties that precede and follow the Block Party and Public Meeting in July 2022
- Reserved/VIP seating at all events/functions (July and November 2022)

34. What is included in the VIP Reception benefit?

The VIP Reception benefit includes access to the VIP receptions and after parties that precede and follow the Block Party and Public Meeting in July 2022.

35. Will VIP passes be available for sale?

No, VIP passes will **not** be available for sale.

36. When will Leadership Giving Gift Packages be distributed?

Leadership Giving gift packages will be distributed at the Centennial Boule only (July 2022). If a donor qualifies for these items but does not attend the July event, the items will be shipped to them.

37. When do I need to provide the name(s) of the person(s) receiving free registration via Leadership Giving?

Leadership Giving benefits will be based on actual giving as of 3/31/2022. Donors earning free registration via Leadership Giving will be contacted with instructions on how to complete their free registration when the pledge is completed, or no later than 4/30/2022 (whichever comes first). In the case of a group pledge, the primary donor will be contacted.

38. Can Leadership Giving benefits (including free registration and/or VIP passes) be earned and/or used by anyone?

Leadership Giving benefits can be earned and/or utilized by anyone who donates at the outlined Leadership Giving levels. As a reminder, only financial members of Sigma Gamma Rho will have access to business meetings.

39. For giving levels that earn both free registration and VIP privileges, does the person receiving the free registration have to be the same person who receives the VIP privileges? Can the person(s) attending Centennial Boule (July 2022) and the Centennial Founders Celebration (November 2022) be different?

At **each** respective celebration (July 2022 and November 2022), the same person(s) receiving the free registration(s) will also receive the VIP pass(es).

For example, Sorors A & B make a combined pledge and give at the 'Keepers of the Flame' level of giving and therefore earn:

- 1 Centennial Boule Registration (July 2022),
- 1 Centennial Founders' Weekend registration (November 2022)
- 1 VIP Full Access pass (July & November 2022)
- 1 VIP Reception pass (July 2022)

If Soror A utilizes the free registration for July 2022, she would also receive all other VIP access benefits for July 2022. Soror B can utilize the free registration for November 2022, and would likewise receive all other VIP access benefits for the November 2022 celebration.

40. What is the date by which Life Membership fees have to be paid to be recognized as a Life Member for Centennial Boule 2022?

Members must pay their life membership fees in full by May 1, 2022 to be recognized as a Life Member for Centennial Boule 2022.

41. I am participating in Centennial Leadership Giving via Network For Good. Will my donation be reflected within my profile when I log into the national website?

Only monies donated directly to Sigma Gamma Rho are reflected within members' profiles when they log into the national website. Donors participating in Leadership Giving via Network For Good are able to log into their Network For Good account to see a history of their giving, retrieve donation receipts, update their user profile, and manage recurring donations.

42.I registered for Centennial but am considering becoming a Leadership Giver at a level that includes free registration. Can I have the amount I paid for registration credited towards my giving or will I receive a refund of my registration fees?

Registration fees that have already been paid will not be applied as a credit against Leadership Giving pledges. However, donors who register for Centennial and subsequently participate in Leadership Giving at a level that includes free registration will have their registration fee refunded if they choose to use the free registration for themselves.
